The mission of St. Francis College affirms “mutual respect throughout the entire College community” to be a cornerstone established by both the Franciscan heritage and the Catholic tradition. In keeping with its mission, the Code of Ethics is established to make manifest the tenets of respect as they apply to the students, employees, and representatives of St. Francis College as well as to the College itself. Accordingly, the St. Francis College community supports the following Code of Ethics:

- To demonstrate a high regard for the dignity of each human life by treating every person with collegiality and consideration, by protecting their personal privacy, by welcoming their diversity, and by safeguarding each from discrimination and harassment.**
- To demonstrate professional integrity by exercising diligence in the performance of one’s duties and by aspiring constantly to improve the working and learning environment.**
- To demonstrate integrity of character by obeying all laws and regulations and avoiding any conduct or activity that would cause harm to St. Francis College, its students, employees or associates.**
- To demonstrate fairness and honesty, and to engender trust, in our relationships with St. Francis College, its students, employees, and representatives.**
- To demonstrate loyalty to the St. Francis College community and its associates by refraining from behavior which encompasses or suggests personal gain, financial or otherwise.**
